- 3 Three times winners of the prestigious U17 tournament the Al Kass Cup in Doha

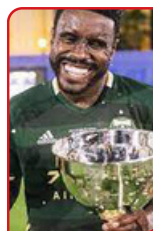
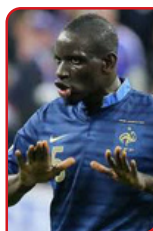
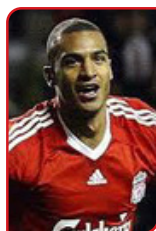
